









Block – ¼” Foot Nine Patch



Fabric	Colour	Size (inches)	Preparation
Nine Patch	Green	3 ¼ x 3 ¼	Cut 4
Nine Patch	Red	3 ¼ x 3 ¼	Cut 4
Nine Patch	Button	3 ¼ x 3 ¼	Cut 1
Notes:			

Needle Plate: Straight 	Foot: ¼” Foot O 	Thread: White 	Needle: Janome Sharp 12 
Stitch: Sewing Applications 	> Quilt tab 	> Straight Stitch 	
Settings: Press Foot-up key 			



1. Create a disappearing nine patch block. Lay the 9 blocks out to create the nine patches.



2. Stitch the blocks using the ¼” seam. Press the seams.



3. Using the rotary cutter cut the block in half through the centre to create four separate blocks.



4. Rotate two blocks. Stitch and press to create the final block



5. Trim block to 8” square.
